



Vasectomy Cancellation and Rescheduling Policy

Please plan carefully. We understand that unexpected circumstances arise. Because vasectomy appointments reserve procedure time, the following rules apply to cancellations, rescheduling, late arrivals, and missed appointments.

At least 7 days notice

You may cancel or reschedule your vasectomy without a fee or penalty when you give the office at least 7 calendar days notice before the scheduled procedure.

Less than 7 days notice

We do not charge a cancellation fee solely because you gave less than 7 days notice. However, before another vasectomy appointment can be scheduled, you must place a \$200 return-to-schedule deposit.

How the \$200 deposit works

1. The \$200 deposit is returned to you after you arrive for and complete the vasectomy at the rescheduled date and time.
2. Once the new appointment is scheduled, that date and time cannot be changed again for any reason, including medical emergencies or events beyond your control.
3. If you miss the rescheduled appointment, the \$200 deposit is forfeited and Texas Vasectomy Center will not schedule another vasectomy appointment for you.
4. For purposes of this policy, arriving more than 20 minutes late is considered a missed appointment.

Important: A patient who forfeits the deposit or misses the rescheduled appointment will need to arrange vasectomy care with another practice.
